- 3. Update from TCC (Bandini)
  - 3.1 TCC Orgainization
    - The changes in membership were discussed. A rotation mechanism for the chair was established and the current chair is Matt Evans. Brina Montoya, Jared Green and Nasli Jessler were elected as new members.
  - 3.2 New proposal for Energy Geotechnics TC
    - A proposal for a new technical committee in Energy Geotechnics was received last year. The proposal was reviewed by the G-I board of governors, which suggested to engage the committees and members about the possibility to establish this new committee.

    - Proposals for special projects were reviewed by the TCC (16 projects were received, for a total request \$170k). A number of projects were funded for a total of \$70k. A best practice guideline is available to guide future proposal submissions and special project implementation.

    - Plans for Geo-congress 2024 (Vancouver) were also discussed, including a reminder that abstract submission is set for this February 3rd, 2023.
    - Cassie Rutherford encouraged discussion about possible strategies to clarify the strategy that will be used in the future to organize a session and coordinate the review process. It was agreed that improvements in this

- direction may increase the level of engagement of the committee and session chairs and increase the success of the sessions.
